Vision and Hearing Screening

Volunteers will assist school district nurses in testing students hearing and vision. Both screenings happen on the same day. This will take place on Fri. Oct. 6.

School Pictures

Volunteers will assist professional photographers while they are taking student photos by handing out combs, picking students up at class and receiving payment envelopes. This date will be Thurs. Sept 21.

Reading Buddy

Reading Buddy volunteers read with 2nd grade students one afternoon a week. The reading is done one-to-one with students from several classrooms. This will run from Nov. through May.

Library Helper

Volunteers will assist our Librarian, Barbara Soel, with a multitude of tasks. This may include shelving books, changing bulletin boards or checking books out to students. Any time is a great time to work in the library. Help is always welcome!

Check-a-Child

Check-a-child is a program designed to ensure that every child that does not come to school is accounted for. This would involve making phone calls to family members to confirm they are aware that their child is not in school that day. This is done each morning and volunteers usually sign up for the same day each week.

Room Parent

The room parent acts as the liaison between the teacher and other parents in organizing parties, field trip chaperones, or any other volunteer needs the teacher may have.
